Impact of premium use	
What has been the impact on pupils' participation?	Increased levels of activity at playtimes as a result of the investment in playground gym equipment. PE Teacher has targeted specific pupils to get involved in active playtimes.
What has been the impact on pupils' attainment?	Increased opportunity for swimming resulted in 40% of our year 6 pupils being able to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres. In addition all of our year 6 pupils made an increase in improvement in their swimming ability.
How has the premium allowed pupils to develop active lifestyles?	PE, sport and physical activity is shared with and supported by the parents and encouraged at home.
How will the school sustain the improvements?	Using the expertise we have within our own staff to support, coach and train other members of staff. Using the funding to make it possible for our children to participate in sports competitions and tournaments during and outside of school time. Purchasing sports equipment.
